PAYMENT OF SUBS

For clarification, in order to set up your payment for subscriptions you need to set up a standing order and not a direct debit.

“**Standing orders** are customers’ instructions to their bank to pay a set amount, to

a named beneficiary, at regular intervals (say on the 1st of the month) – *either* for a specific period of time or until cancelled. Typically, a standing order might be used to pay a fixed amount to a savings account or to a local club.” The Squadron will not be claiming funds by direct debit and you will need to set up the standing order.

You should all have received the letters detailing the Squadron’s banking details, if not, please email Kim Medland and they can be re-sent to you.

**It would also be appreciated if you would confirm when you have set up the standing order arrangement so that the Treasurer can be informed and we can keep a record of payments.
