## Search and Rescue Exercise on Dartmoor - 27/28 November

The Wing has been invited, along with Devon & Somerset Wing and Police cadets to take part in a large Multi Agency Exercise on Dartmoor on the above date.

This will involve Rescue groups from Dartmoor and all over the country, also the Police, Military, Ambulance service, Fire service and possibly helicopters from the Services. The role of the cadet organisations will be to provide the walking groups that would be on the moor when this operation is put into place.

Cadet teams will be either taken to their start points or walk from the camp, or they may just have to set up tents and wait, or be casualties waiting for rescue. Each team will have at least one member of staff with them.

Once the team have been located by the rescue team they will be transported back to Okehampton camp by various means, e.g. land rover, minibus, stretcher, so the rescue services can ensure they have the planning in place to be able to implement this exercise if required in real life situations.

Although cadets will be off the moor and ready to depart by 1630, the camp has been booked for the whole weekend so it is likely that other activities will be organised.

If you are interested:

- please put your name on the board no later than 23rd July.
- Hand a £5 deposit into the office.

This is this is a good exercise for cadets who have experience on the moor, to understand what happens when the emergency services have to cope with a disaster exercise, and also new cadets who would benefit from the experience of Dartmoor ready for future activities.
